Minutes and Matters Arising

LM was given a laptop solely for the accounts, which will be handed over to the next treasurer. She also gave a brief rundown of the club's accounts. FTBC has paid around £500 to enter players into county competitions.

Welfare

Bar Manager

Jonathan Wright from Greene King had visited to advise on pipe cleaning. He is looking into new pumps for the bar and simplifying the pipes in the cellar. LM, JC and SM will continue to act as joint bar managers. Bar staff are asked to ensure the bar is re-stocked after each shift.

Fixtures and Mid-Week Captain

All is going well, although there was one complaint about how the club competitions were re-drawn. GL explained there had been a system issue requiring a re-draw, which has now been rectified, and apologised for any confusion. All result sheets for club competitions should be placed in the white mailbox just inside the front door.

Obelisk / Floodlit Report

A question was raised about whether Kettering League games should take priority over the Obelisk League. County games are known to take priority. This question will be put to LR.

Grounds Maintenance

SM has been in touch with RT Machinery about the mower service and a problem with the tick-over, and is waiting for RT to reply.

FTBC is to receive £500 from the George Foundation. Thanks were given to Corey Donaldson for sorting this.
